

**COMMISSION ON AGING MINUTES**

**ORAL COMMUNICATIONS:** Under Government Code Section 54954.3, members of the audience may address the Commission on any item of interest to the public or any agenda item before or during the Commission's consideration of the item.

**ORDER OF BUSINESS:** The meeting was called to order at 5:20 P.M. A motion was made by Comm. Roberts and seconded by Comm. Hanchey to approve the meeting minutes of March 28, 2013.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

The Commission on Aging Resource Guide is printed and complete. Comm. Klooster delivered the books to the meeting. Express Graphics printed the guides and charges will be billed either to the City or the Parks & Recreation Department. It was suggested that the Guide be distributed at the Senior Games scheduled for June 6<sup>th</sup>, the Galt Library, Senior Lunch program at the Chabolla Center, the Parks & Recreation Department and the Annual Senior Christmas Luncheon. Comm. Roberts made a motion to set a date for September to begin reviewing the Guide for 2014. Comm. Klooster seconded the motion. Galt resident, Ralph Cortez suggested that the guide be available electronically and on the City of Galt web site.

Janice Reuthinger from the Galt Rotary Club was present to discuss the upcoming annual Senior Games. They sponsor this event each year and will be in charge of opening ceremonies. The Commission on Aging is responsible for the Senior Resource Fair and will be contacting the vendors. There will be approximately 20 vendors. Vendor set-up will be in the parking lot. A final vendor count will be needed at the next commission meeting on May 25<sup>th</sup>. Vendors will be invited to stay for lunch with advance notice. In lieu of a table rental fee we will ask that a donation be made to Meals on Wheels. Janice will be purchasing a book of transportation tickets from Storer for seniors that need a ride to and from the event. There will be a cake-walk again this year and donations are needed.

The question was asked if there was going to be a walk this year. Comm. Hanchey said that having a walk would draw seniors that are more mobile. Comm. Hanchey made a motion to reinstate the walk to the senior games. Comm. Klooster seconded the motion. The Commission on Aging will be in charge of this event. The walk will begin at 9 A.M. and finish at approximately 9:30 A.M. Comm. Nicolaus asked if the commission should have some kind of identification if we are in charge and leading the walk. A photo ID badge is available by contacting Toni at the City.

With the completion of the resource guide we are now ready to make a presentation to the City Council. Comm. Nicolaus will contact the city clerk's office in time to be placed on the agenda for the May 21<sup>st</sup> meeting. Comm. Roberts will present the resource guide to the City Council and give them a commission update.

Discussion on the Character Coalition was tabled until the next meeting. The Commission on Aging membership to the Galt Senior Club will be billed to the City.
