The Galt Public Safety Committee was called to order on March 25, 2013, at 6:01 pm. to discuss the following items:

ROLL CALL found Mr. Singleton, Mr. Lagge, Mr. Doak, Mr. McCune, Mr. Bezanson, Councilman Crews and Mr. Shelton present. We saluted the American flag.

MINUTES: The minutes from the January meeting were discussed. Shelton moved to approve, Doak seconded, minutes were approved by unanimous vote.

ORAL COMMUNICATIONS: The floor was opened for ORAL COMMUNICATIONS. There were none.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Gwen Owen updated us on traffic issues, and addressed concerns over uncontrolled cross walks. Gwen will bring an Uncontrolled Crosswalk Evaluation Form to the May meeting.
- Shelton voiced ongoing concerns brought to him by a citizen in the Sparrow/Elm area over vehicles speeding, burning out, running the stop sign and using jake brakes. Gwen Owens offered to look up the last complaint.
- The Annual Forum was discussed. May 11<sup>th</sup> was decided as the date, in conjunction with Public Safety Day and Bike Rodeo.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Horse in City Limits- Officers had been told subject was moving out of the area soon.
- Panhandling was discussed as a concern as some panhandlers become aggressive.

COMMENTS BY COMMITTEE MEMBERS:

- Lagge noted that the refuge area on Fermoy had been damaged, but has now been repaired and looks great. The lines on the roadway at Simmerhorn and Lincoln are barely visible however, and need to be repainted.
- Shelton asked for reminder e-mails of upcoming meetings.
- Shelton asked about leads on vehicle vandalism.
- Lagge also voiced a concern of Mylar balloons being released and caught in power lines. These balloons are sold with a weight attached in an attempt to thwart such dangers.
