

COMMISSION ON AGING MINUTES

Hanchey made a motion to correct the minutes of July 25, 2013 to include discussing the election of a president at the August 22, 2013 meeting. Comm. Roberts seconded the motion. The minutes were accepted as amended by a motion made by Comm. Hanchey and seconded by Comm. Klooster.

Comm. Klooster gave each person present a flier with information regarding a newly formed organization, the Galt Community Alliance. Galt Resident Ralph Cortez explained that the group consists of business owners, Galt residents, and local volunteers. The purpose of the Alliance is to coordinate community calendar events. The City Council approved the Alliance and all Galt commissions will be invited to meet this group.

Discussion continued on the possibility of the Commission on Aging having a health fair in Galt for local seniors. Comm. Roberts will make a presentation at our next meeting. The month of May is Senior Citizen month and would be a perfect time to have such an event.

Comm. Hanchey informed the Commission that AARP has raised the fees for the safety-driving course. AARP needs to be contacted to check if a replacement volunteer has been selected to continue the classes as the previous instructor has resigned. Comm. Roberts has volunteered to call AARP. Comm. Roberts will report his findings at the next meeting.
