**CALL MEETING TO ORDER:** Chairperson called the meeting to order at 3:30 pm.

1. Adopt-A-Street - Ortega to research planters. Discussed Shirley Robert's situation with her fencing adjacent to the sidewalk. She suggested instead of sidewalk planters for her property that she would perhaps do hanging baskets of flowers on her side of the fence. Duwel suggested that she might consider removing part of her fencing at the corner and repositioning it diagonally, thus creating a spot for a planter.
2. Home of the Month - St. Claire presented three homes for selection in Section 2. Approved was the first choice of 1068 Elk Hills Drive and the second is 664 Canyon Creek Way. Liz to research and contact owners. Johnson will select from Section 3. She requested a list of previous awarded homes prior to her selection. She will contact Liz.
3. Harvey Park - St. Claire stated that the completed bench constructed by Brandon Moore had been delivered to her home for painting which has been completed. She will contact Public Works and Parks & Rec for pick-up and installation.
4. Rose Garden - St. Claire to contact Barbara Payne for final answer if the grounds around the Library belong to the city or the county before we can proceed with this project.
5. Business of the Year – None
6. Adopt-A-Street - None but it was suggested by Ortega that we have a "Clean-Up Galt" day with volunteers from the high school that need community service hours. Lopes indicated that the furniture store sometimes has discarded items behind the store that becomes an eyesore. To be checked.

fertilizer and pest control. Purchase up to \$50.00 was approved and Ortega will purchase the item, deliver it to Gary and submit bill to Liz. Also, previously approved was the expenditure of up to \$50.00 for planter flowers requested by Duwel.
