The Galt Parks & Recreation Department is happy to announce the "School's Out!" Academic & Recreation (SOAR) Program will be offered this summer! Participants will be able to visit the Gora Aquatic Center each day. It is available to all children who will be entering grades 1-6 in August 2016. The Summer SOAR Program runs Mondays through Fridays from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm.

Monthly Fees: Monthly fees are due one month in advance (i.e. September's tuition is due no later than August 1st).

Registration items needed:

- Copy of birth certificate, current shot records, completed registration packet, and \$25 registration fee
- Students must be 3 years of age by September 1, 2016 to qualify for the preschool program
- No discount for multiple students (siblings)
- Classes will begin on September 6th
- The class site for the upcoming school year is Classroom F1 at Marengo Ranch Elementary School.
- Pre-registration is required.

SOAR operates in conjunction with the Galt Elementary School District calendar. Children check in immediately following school dismissal, and can be picked up any time before 6:00 pm. Children are not required to attend every day. (All minimum day hours will be followed according to the school calendar).

The program runs Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays from 2:30 pm – 6 pm and Wednesdays from 1 pm – 6 pm. The fee is \$115 per month – due the last Thursday of the previous month (with a \$20 late fee applied after this day).

Keep Pets Safe this 4th of July

Fireworks and barbecues are synonymous with the 4th of July – they also pose danger for your pet. Here are some tips to keep your pets safe:

- Microchip and collar your pets with identification tags – more pets go missing on the 4th of July than any other day of the year!
- Keep your pets indoors at home – but some animals can become destructive when frightened, so remove any items your pet could destroy or that would be harmful if chewed or ingested.
- Secure gates, doors, and windows - in their fear, pets may try to escape.
- Never leave your pet in the car – pets can suffer serious health effects, even death, in a few short minutes. It is also against the law.
- Do not tether your pets – they may become entangled, risking injury or death.

Water Conservation and Meter Updates

Galt water customers have done a great job of meeting the State mandates for water conservation over the past year. The City met its cumulative requirement to achieve a 32% reduction in water usage between June 2015 and February 2016, when compared to the same months in 2013. Beginning in March of this year, the conservation mandate was adjusted to 29%, which the City has also met. In late May, based upon a near normal amount of rainfall this past winter, the State Water Board revised its conservation mandate. Under the new regulations cities may now ‘self-certify’ a lower conservation target if they can demonstrate an ability to meet water supply needs in a sustainable manner, presuming another 3 year drought. As a result, the City has reverted to a Stage 2 – Water Alert that allows outdoor watering up to 3 days per week:

- Even addresses: Wednesday, Friday and/or Sunday
- Odd addresses: Tuesday, Thursday and/or Saturday
- No outdoor irrigation is allowed on Mondays

Water meters are an important tool to help the City meet conservation targets, providing customers an economic incentive to reduce water use and detect leaks. With meters now installed on all water services within the city, the next step is to transition flat rate customers to metered water rates. Flat-rate water customers with new meters installed prior to July 15, 2015 received their first metered water bill in early June, covering the usage period from 5/1/16 to 5/15/16. Customers who received their new meter after July 15, 2015 will receive their first metered water bill in October of 2016, covering the usage period from 9/1/16 to 9/15/16. These initial metered billings reflect only 15 days of usage. Under the flat rate billing system, customers are billed for the previous calendar month and the following calendar month in advance. Under the metered billing system customers pay for two prior months of actual usage, ending on the 15th of the month prior to the billing date. This results in the first metered bill covering only 15 days of usage and one-half of the normal base monthly charge, because the previous calendar month has already been billed. After the first transitional bill, future water bills will reflect two full months of actual water usage and base monthly charges.
