



# RECOMMENDED ACTION

- ADOPT A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING:
  - EXECUTION OF CONTRACT WITH WOOD RODGERS IN AMOUNT OF \$1,243,686
  - CONTINGENCY OF \$124,314
  - EXECUTION OF AMENDMENTS WITHIN CONTINGENCY
  - ELIMINATE WATER CIP #55A AND REPLACE WITH WASTEWATER CIP #55A1
  - SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$1,464,000 FROM FUND 007 FUND BALANCE

# BACKGROUND

- DRIVER – ARSENIC DISCHARGE LIMITS FOR WWTP
- SOURCE – FILTER BACKWASH WATER AT THREE WTPs
- FIELD TESTING AND PRELIMINARY DESIGN CONDUCTED IN 2014 & 2015
- INITIAL SLUDGE PROCESSING PROJECT TOO COSTLY AT \$5M
- OTHER OPTIONS REVIEWED FOR LOWER CAPITAL AND O&M COSTS
- REPLACEMENT OF EXISTING WELL WITH DEEP WELL BEST ALTERNATIVE



# PROJECT FUNDING

- WWTP DISCHARGE PERMIT REQUIRES ARSENIC REDUCTION BY 9/2018
- FUNDING SOURCE ALTERNATIVES: SRF, BONDS, WW RESERVES
- WW RESERVES ADEQUATE TO COVER PROJECT
- BEST ALTERNATIVE TOTAL PROJECT COST ESTIMATED AT \$4M
- WW FINANCING PLAN ADOPTED IN APRIL 2016
- WW COST OF SERVICE RFP PROCESS UNDER WAY

# PROPOSED PROJECT

- INSTALL TEST WELL FOR GW TESTING AND DEEP WELL DESIGN
- REPLACE EXISTING WELL AT INDUSTRIAL WTP WITH NEW DEEP WELL
- ELIMINATE ARSENIC TREATMENT PROCESS/DISCHARGE



# OTHER COMPONENTS

- ENVIRONMENTAL PROCESS
- DEMOLITION OF EQUIPMENT AT QUAIL HOLLOW SITE
- POSSIBLE NEED FOR ADDITIONAL LAND FOR WELL SITE
- TRANSFER NEW DEEP WELL TO WATER FUND UPON COMPLETION



# PROCUREMENT PROCESS

- ISSUED DESIGN RFP IN MAY TO 24 FIRMS
- RECEIVED FOUR PROPOSALS
- INTERVIEWED TOP TWO RANKED TEAMS
- WOOD RODGERS SELECTED AS THE MOST RESPONSIVE



# RECOMMENDED ACTION

- ADOPT A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING:
  - EXECUTION OF CONTRACT WITH WOOD RODGERS IN AMOUNT OF \$1,243,686
  - CONTINGENCY OF \$124,314
  - EXECUTION OF AMENDMENTS WITHIN CONTINGENCY
  - ELIMINATE WATER CIP #55A AND REPLACE WITH WASTEWATER CIP #55A1
  - SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$1,464,000 FROM FUND 007 FUND BALANCE
