

parades • exhibits • flashlight walks • contests • youth programs**



Capital Improvement Project Updates

Twin Cities Road at State Route 99 Improvements

Preliminary design studies for improvements to relieve congestion and improve pedestrian and bicycle access at the two signalized intersections on Twin Cities Road and East and West Stockton Boulevards have been completed.

The Traffic analysis was presented to Caltrans and the preferred options are modern day roundabouts with a new southbound onramp on State Route 99. Final design and environmental studies will continue throughout 2010 and 2011. Construction is planned for Spring 2012. Contact the Public Works Department at 366-7260 should you have questions.



Central Galt Interchange Project

Advertisement for bids, award of the construction contract and start of work are planned for July, August and September of this year. The first phase of construction will be the import of 350,000 cubic yards of soil to build the east and west approaches to the new A Street overcrossing. The first year of construction will entail the placement of the reinforced concrete A Street structure. After its completion and in the second year of construction, A Street will be open to traffic while the C Street structure is demolished and rebuilt as a 6-lane structure.

Walker Community Park Project

With the return of dry weather and dry soil conditions, the mass grading and underground utilities are now under construction for Phase I of the park. Construction will continue throughout this year and into 2011. Contact Public Works Department at 366-7260 should you have questions.



2010 Sewer Line Replacement Project

Work locations are at the 5th Street alley, from E Street to G Street, and Chabolla Avenue, from Caroline Avenue to South Lincoln Way. Work is anticipated to be complete by August 2010. The new pipe will be installed mechanically by pulling through the existing pipe locations. Trenching will only be at the entrance pit, receiving pit, and lateral service connection areas. This installation method minimizes traffic impact to local residents, but we ask for your patience and consideration.

All resident and business access will be kept open but we ask affected residents to plan ahead when driving through the construction zone. Contact Public Works Department at 366-7260 should you have questions.

Railroad Pedestrian Safety Crossings

Construction began in June. Work includes the installation of separate pedestrian pathways across the UPRR tracks at Carillion Boulevard, Elm Avenue at Industrial Drive, Elm Avenue at McFarland Street, A Street, C Street and F Street. Motorist should be aware of construction zones until work is completed by October 2010. Call Public Works at 366-7260 should you have questions.



Northeast Area Bicycle Lane

Construction began in June to improve bicycle safety and widening roadways to complete bike lane connection where gaps exist. Roadway construction will occur on East Stockton Boulevard between Adare Way and Walnut Avenue and near the State Route 99 off ramp on Twin Cities Road. Minor striping will be placed from East Stockton Boulevard to refresh bike lane delineation easterly along Twin Cities Road. Motorist should be aware of construction zone areas and plan for travel delays during certain construction operations until work is completed by September 2010. 2010 Transit Bus Shelter Improvement Project

Be on the look out for our new transit bus shelters! The 2010 Transit Bus Stop Shelter Improvement Project will install 4 new transit bus shelters at three locations: Chabolla Community Center, Marian O Lawrence Library, and City Hall. Installation is expected to be complete by August 2010. Contact Public Works Department at 366-7260 should you have questions.

Galt Redevelopment Agency Revitalization

The City of Galt Redevelopment Agency partnered with commercial property owners to make improvements to the exterior of buildings in targeted areas. The Agency's Facade Improvement Program (FIP) provides matching funds (\$15,000 maximum) for exterior improvements to commercial properties in the Downtown Revitalization and Historic Preservation Specific Plan Area.

The goal of the FIP is to preserve and beautify the appearance of older buildings along the commercial corridors in the older part of the City. Buildings on Lincoln Way and C Street are currently undergoing revitalization using the FIP. All businesses, Gary's Country Deli, Metro PCS, Super Tortas, Sacramento County Department of Human Assistance, and Robinson's Taekwondo remain open for the renovation.

School Resource Officer

By the beginning of the school year in fall of 2010 the Galt Police Department will have a full time School Resource Officer hired and ready to go. Police administration met with school officials from both districts in April this year to discuss implementation of the new position.

The School Resource Officer will be funded through Measure R and will work with both districts as a liaison between the campuses and the department to assist in providing a better educational environment for school aged children. Part of the identified need is to soften barriers between law enforcement and school aged children through leadership and educational programs.

The position is assigned for an indefinite amount of time to be active on each school campus during the school year to develop and implement these programs or to enhance current programs.


