

**CITY OF GALT

MINUTES

Mayor Shelton called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

The roll call found Shelton, Goethel, Lagge, Magnuson, and Singleton present. We saluted the American Flag.

The minutes of the last meeting were presented to all members in advance, and no changes were recommended.

New Business:

The Galt Area Neighborhood Accountability Board (NAB) gave a presentation. Terri Grosz and Tiphany Farris told the group that NAB is a juvenile diversion program designed for first time offenders who have committed low level crimes.

The board is run by 10 volunteers who call the juveniles parents, interview the juveniles, and determine fit for the program, which includes up to 80 hours of community service. The juveniles selected work with the NAB board for 6 months before they are released by the hearing panel. The Galt Area NAB board is one of 14 similar in Sacramento County.

The board is looking for more volunteers / board members.

Mayor Shelton suggested that Lt. Vizzusi assist the NAB board by contacting the media and developing some interest in a story about the good work that they do.

Roundtable:

Mr. Halladay updated the group on the cities efforts in the area of light standard replacement.

Mr. Magnuson spoke about some speed issues in his neighborhood and asked the group about the success of speed bump placement. The group was not in support of speed bumps for many reasons. Lt. Vizzusi will coordinate some special enforcement activity in the neighborhood and some education to area residents in an effort to help solve the problem.

Mr. Lagge updated the group by providing a press release in reference to calling PG&E before residents begin an excavation on their property to prevent personal injury, and damage to critical lines and equipment.

Mr. Goethel informed the group that mosquitoes have gone dormant for the winter for the most part.

Lt. Vizzusi gave a brief update on the Police Department and reported to the group that in reviewing preliminary figures, it appears that there will be another double digit year of crime reductions due in part because of the great police / community partnerships and all of the hard work by the men and woman of the Galt Police Department.
