- Traffic concerns at Chabolla and Caroline were discussed, 2 Way stop is not feasible.

- Question asked regarding cameras in the parks. Not all of the parks have them but will at some point, project is in the CIP. Curfew in the parks is 10pm.
- We discussed the field mowing (100ft from structures and 30ft perimeters.
