

COMMISSION ON AGING MINUTES

ORAL COMMUNICATIONS: Under Government Code Section 54954.3, members of the audience may address the Commission on any item of interest to the public or any agenda item before or during the Commission's consideration of the item.

ORDER OF BUSINESS: The meeting was called to order at 5:10 P.M. The February 23, 2012 minutes were approved by a motion made by Comm. Klooster and seconded by Comm. Hanchey. No minutes were taken for the special meeting on April 17, 2012 to gather information and update the Senior Resource Book.

OTHER BUSINESS:

Election of officers was the first order of business. Comm. Hanchey nominated Comm. Klooster for president but Comm. Klooster declined. Comm. Wallin was nominated but also declined. Comm. Hanchey nominated Comm. Klooster for vice president. All voted in favor of Comm. Klooster for the vice president nomination. Comm. Klooster nominated Comm. Nicolaus for the position of secretary; all voted in favor of the nomination. The election of president was tabled to the next meeting,

The City Council approved a \$200.00 budget for Commission expenses as they arise. An invoice or receipt needs to be presented to the City Council and a check will be issued for payment or reimbursement. Comm. Hanchey will contact Sharon Wilbur, president of the Galt Senior Club for an invoice to cover senior club membership for the Commission on Aging commissioners. Membership dues are \$10.00 per year per person.

Karen Ellner from the Galt Rotary Club attended the meeting to update the members on the upcoming Senior Games to be held on Thursday, June 7, 2012. There will be no walk this year. Vendors have been invited to "rent" a table space for \$10.00 per table to sell items and crafts of interest to seniors. There will be games such as bingo, poker, car races and a cakewalk. The Commission on Aging will provide donuts for the volunteers and coffee will also be available. A hamburger lunch will be provided by the Galt Rotary Club and will be held at noon by the pool. There will be a drawing for raffle prizes after lunch. Free transportation will be provided to those calling two days in advance so buss tickets can be purchased. Entertainment provided by the First & Last Dancers. All volunteers will wear nametags during the event.

Comm. Hanchey reported on the AARP Safety Driving class sponsored by the Commission on Aging and will be held on May 14th and May 21st from 8:30 to 12:30 P.M. at the Chabolla Community Center. The cost is \$12 for members of AARP and \$14 for non-members.

The Senior Resource book was discussed and when updated and complete will be distributed to the senior facilities, apartments and mobile home parks in the Galt area. Discussion to visit senior facilities has been tabled to the next meeting. Comm. Wallin suggested that a "senior section" be added to the Chamber of Commerce Directory next year. The updated information needs to be submitted to Comm. Wallin no later than January 2013.
