The Galt Public Safety Committee was called to order on May 21, 2012, at 6:10 pm. to discuss the following items:

ROLL CALL found Mr. Shelton, Mr. Lagge, Mr. McCune, Mr. Bezanson, and Mr. Singleton present. We saluted the American flag.

MINUTES: The minutes from the March meeting were discussed, Magnuson moved to approve, Lagge seconded, minutes were approved by roll call vote.

NEW BUSINESS:

- The meeting was conducted in the setting of a "Public Forum". Members of the public were in attendance and were encouraged to participate.
- Chief George Apple of CSD explained the Fire Departments Weed Abatement process, tier I, II and III, up to and including property liens.
- Gwen Owens of Public Works spoke on the City's process of handling complaint calls.
- Committee member Lagge spoke about "Call Before You Dig" and provided literature and bumper stickers.
- Mr. Singleton requested traffic studies in the area of Vintage Oak and Carillion on behalf of Councilman Crews.
- Mr. Solis advised on the upcoming Bus Rodeo (last weekend in May) and Farmer's Market (June 5th – September 5th)
- Lt. Vizzusi spoke about the upcoming National Night Out (August 7th), the new Police computer system and also about recent gang activity in the City.
- Councilman Shelton announced the City's Independence Celebration fireworks will be June 30th.
- Fire Chief Apple advised the Fireworks Task Force will again be active this Fireworks season.
- Mr. Hutchinson spoke about the school district's plan to discontinue bus service and the impact he feels this will have on the safety of the students.

- Mr. Solis spoke of last weekend's Strawberry Festival.
- Lt. Vizzusi reminded all to sign up for TIP411.
