- Gwen Owens reported on visibility and speed surveys being conducted in the Vintage Oak/Carillion area. A reduced speed limit in this area is possible. She also advised further follow up needs to be done regarding school zones and traffic cites.
- Ralph Doak asked about Safe Routes to School on the Mayor's behalf.
- Mr. Singleton brought up concerns regarding the Elm/Amador construction project and All Phase Engineering.
- Mr. Singleton commented on the brickwork in the street looking dirty. Gwen agreed to check into this further.
- Chief Bowen spoke of the Twin Cities Rd Park N Ride and the conflict with the "City's" new bus and the State's parking lot. Our officers will patrol the area, however, better fencing around the lot is likely the State's responsibility.
